PRINCE2® is now a defacto standard for managing successful projects and is being used by organisations in more than 50 countries around the world.

What is PRINCE2®?

PRINCE2® (PRojects IN Controlled Environments) is a structured approach to managing projects. It was first developed by the UK Government in 1989 and has now become the preferred project management method, being used in over 50 countries worldwide. It is an excellent generic, best-practice approach suitable for the management of all types of projects.

What are the aims of the PRINCE2® Foundation Course?

The PRINCE2® Foundation Course provides delegates with a good understanding of this project management method and a firm basis for its application in your organisation. It leads to the PRINCE2® Foundation level certification.

Who should attend?

Those working in projects who require an understanding of formal project management methods and an effective way of delivering projects. This includes people working on project teams, people initiating projects, business representatives, team leaders, senior management and those aspiring to move into a project management role. Candidates should have some project management experience or exposure to projects through a support role.

What is the structure of the course?

The course structure comprises classroom instructions, discussions, group exercises, case studies and exam preparation. Up to 2 hours work is required each evening to consolidate the day's information.

What is the structure of the Foundation Exam?

The PRINCE2® 2009 Foundation Exam is a one hour closed book, multiple choice exam. There are 75 questions in all, including five trial questions that are not counted in the overall score. The maximum score achievable is 70. To pass the examination, delegates must achieve a minimum total mark of 50 per cent, which is a score of at least 35 marks out of 70. On passing the exam, candidates have the choice of acquiring Practitioner accreditation. This involves an additional 1.5 days of training, culminating in a 2.5 hour exam.

How long is the course?

3.5 days, from 9am to 5pm and 9am – 11am on the last day. The Foundation exam is held on the last day. Morning and afternoon tea and lunch are provided.
